



## 112: Say “I Believe In ALLAH And Then Be Steadfast”

### Description

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When the Prophet (peace be upon him) was asked for advice that would enhance one’s spiritual state, he is reported to have said, **“Say; I believe in Allah, and then be steadfast.”** (*Muslim*) This Hadith highlights the importance of emphatically uttering the proclamation of faith (Imaan), and then living by the utterance by steadfastly acting in a manner that affirms the proclamation of faith.
